General Rules

1. The Auckland Classic is a scratch event open to all 2018 TBNZ members.
2. This is a TBNZ certified event, all phases of this tournament will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.
3. There will be a separate Men's, Women's and Youth divisions.
4. Qualifying shall be 8 games moving every two games one pair left and right. One attempt only permitted for each division entered.
5. Check in for all Qualifying squads is 15 minutes prior to advertised time for start of play.
6. The top 10 men, top 8 women and top 8 youth shall advance to their respective Masters final.
7. Ties – should a tie occur for any qualifying position or 1st to 3rd placing in Masters, final positions shall be determined by highest game in that section of play i.e qualifying for qualifying, Masters for Masters. If still tied the second highest game will be used and so on.
8. All Masters will be a head to head match play with 20 points awarded for a win and 10 points for a draw.
9. Pinfall from the qualifying section will be carried forward to Masters.
10. Masters will be a signed check in at reception. If a bowler has not signed in before the stated check in time, the next highest qualified reserve present will be invited to compete.
11. Any tie of final positions for Masters other than 1st to 3rd places shall remain a tie and any prize money shared.
12. The first three placed bowlers after Masters shall play a one game head to head step ladder final to determine final placings. There is no carry forward of pinfall from Masters. From Masters positions 2nd and 3rd will play each other in Match 1 and in Match 2, the winner of Match 1 will play the first placed player from Masters. In each Match the highest placed seed from Masters will decide who bowls first. The step ladder is to be bowled two frames at a time after the first player has bowled frame 1.
13. The allocated step ladder lanes will **NOT** be re-oiled. The lanes to be used will be determined by the Tournament Director but will not be lanes used by those who are to play the step ladder in their last Masters match. The step ladder for both Men and Women will be played between lanes 15 and 24.
14. Dress standards for all sections of this tournament are as follows.
 - Men – dress trousers, tailored shorts, and collared shirt or approved bowling branded shirt e.g. Storm, Hammer etc.
 - Ladies – dress trousers, tailored shorts or skirt and collared shirt or approved bowling branded shirt per above
 - No jeans, no track pants, no cargo trousers or shorts.
15. **Anyone not meeting the dress standard required will not be permitted to bowl. If in Qualifying the deposit will be forfeited.**
16. Any protests are to be made verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing. All disputes will be dealt with by the Tournament Director. The Tournament Director's decision shall be final.
17. Bowlers who enter this tournament are deemed to have read and agreed to the rules listed above.
